- The Plan - identifies the goals, strategies and proposed action steps and pertinent background information. It has been reviewed by the Governor's Interagency Council on Chronic Homelessness and member Agencies and Departments.
- The Matrix - designed to help identify specific actions and objectives in carrying out the Plan and is subject to periodic adjustment. Not all of the items have been fully reviewed and some may be adjusted based on additional input.

We would appreciate your initial thoughts and observations by the end of May 2007. We will continue to entertain comments beyond that time both as to the Plan itself and its subsequent implementation.
