

Park Development

The SCC partners with local city and county agencies to assist in the development of park construction including irrigation and playground installation, construction of concrete and decomposed granite pathways, and planting of trees and shrubs. SCC has built 6 complete parks and upgraded 20.

Urban Forestry

The Sequoia Community Corps has planted thousands of trees and developed dozens of neighborhood parks throughout Tulare County. Over the last 5 years, they have assisted the Urban Tree Foundation in planting approximately 6,000 trees in Tulare and Visalia. They were instrumental in the reforestation of the entire downtown area of Visalia, which includes about 2,000 trees.



Performance Oriented

The SCC incorporates technology to improve the quality of its services. A **Global Positioning System (GPS)** is used to track our fleet of vehicles, improving performance, efficiency, and accountability. Future plans include a **Bar Code System** to identify the most productive placement of recycling containers.

Our mission is to provide young men and women with Job Training, Education, Leadership, and Environmental Awareness through performance of community and conservation work projects.



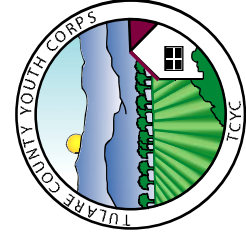
